About This Guide

Generic school shoe requirements based on uniform guidelines.

School Uniform Guidelines

Pupils must wear black school shoes or plain black unbranded trainers as part of the uniform. Shoes that are black and unbranded are acceptable, even if they are trainers; the school does not require a particular brand. The shoes should be flat, comfortable and provide good support for running and using outdoor play equipment. Shoes that display a logo, are a different colour, or have any branding are not allowed. High-heeled shoes, open-toed shoes, boots higher than the ankle and other footwear styles are also not permitted for school days.

Shoe Fitting Guidelines

Children's feet grow quickly - they may need new shoes every 3-4 months depending on age and activity level.

Check for Proper Fit:

- Allow approximately half an inch (1.3 cm) of space between the longest toe and the front of the shoe
- Ensure the width is comfortable with no pinching or bulging
- The heel should fit snugly without slipping
- Shoes should be comfortable immediately - no "breaking in" period needed

When to Replace:

- When there's less than half an inch of growing room
- If the shoe shows signs of wear or damage
- If your child complains of discomfort or pain
- Check regularly for redness or blisters on your child's feet

Measuring Tips:

- Measure both feet while standing
 - Measure at the end of the day when feet are at their largest
 - Have your child wear the type of socks they'll wear with the shoes
 - Use the measuring gauge on page 2 only if you can't get the shoes fitted professionally
 - Shoes from different brands may have different sizing, so it's important to try them on
