About This Guide

Official school shoe requirements based on uniform guidelines.

School Uniform Guidelines

Pupils must wear plain black polishable shoes as their regular school footwear. Shoes with sports brands, logos or trainers are not permitted for everyday wear. Trainers or sports shoes are only allowed during PE lessons and are excluded from the regular school shoe requirement.

PE / Sports Shoes Guidelines

Pupils must wear football boots for football in PE lessons. Trainers or sports shoes are permitted for other PE activities and are the usual footwear for indoor PE lessons. No further footwear requirements are specified for sports, games or swimming lessons.

Shoe Fitting Guidelines

Children's feet grow quickly - they may need new shoes every 3-4 months depending on age and activity level.

Check for Proper Fit:

- Allow approximately half an inch (1.3 cm) of space between the longest toe and the front of the shoe
- Ensure the width is comfortable with no pinching or bulging
- The heel should fit snugly without slipping
- Shoes should be comfortable immediately - no "breaking in" period needed












When to Replace:

- When there's less than half an inch of growing room
- If the shoe shows signs of wear or damage
- If your child complains of discomfort or pain
- Check regularly for redness or blisters on your child's feet

Measuring Tips:

- Measure both feet while standing
- Measure at the end of the day when feet are at their largest
- Have your child wear the type of socks they'll wear with the shoes
- Use the measuring gauge on page 2 only if you can't get the shoes fitted professionally
- Shoes from different brands may have different sizing, so it's important to try them on
